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User Reception of Muslim Pro Apps in Increasing Spiritual Closeness to the Qur'an: A Study of Living Qur'an in the Digital Age

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Abstract

This study aims to examine the user's reception of the Muslim Pro application in increasing spiritual closeness to the Qur'an, using the Living Qur'an approach. In the context of the digital era, Muslim Pro is present as an interactive medium that allows users to easily access holy verses, tafsir, prayer times, dhikr, and other Islamic features. The method used in this study is qualitative with a field approach through interviews, observations, and documentation of active users of the application. The research findings show that the majority of users use this application because of its convenience and practicality in supporting worship. This application is considered to be able to improve worship routines, strengthen spiritual connections, and become a practical alternative in the midst of limited physical access to mushaf. Thus, Muslim Pro can be understood as a concrete form of the Living Qur'an phenomenon that mediates the relationship between the ummah and revelation through digital technology.

Introduction

Very fundamental changes in the situation of Muslims are greatly influenced by globalization that occurs in almost every aspect of human life [1]. This is evidenced by various advances that continue to occur at all times. Starting from the terms of technology, transportation, economy, and science [2]. These changes require us to think critically, adaptively, and have a solid moral foundation in facing the challenges of the times. In the midst of these developments, various modern problems such as social inequality, moral crisis, misuse of technology, and environmental degradation are increasingly worrying [3].

Lebih dari itu, Al-Qur'an berfungsi sebagai penuntun hidup yang memberikan panduan bagi umat Islam dalam menjalani kehidupan [7].

The Qur'an has a special position compared to the previous heavenly books. One of the functions of the Qur'an is to perfect the previous scriptures as well as to straighten out the things that have been deviated from the teachings of those books [8]. The Qur'an, which is the revelation and word of Allah revealed to Muslims through the Prophet Muhammad PBUH, is an undeniably true book and very rich in everything [9]. The virtue of the Qur'an lies in its ability to answer various problems in life. The Qur'an as the main and first source of Islamic teachings teaches and invites humans to always use their intellect and mind to think about all of Allah's creations and to always take their wisdom [10]. In each verse, there are lessons and lessons that are relevant to the condition of society in every era. The Qur'an invites its people to think critically, explore meaning, and apply its teachings in daily life. This makes it a timeless source of inspiration [11].

Islam is a religion with a social mission to form civilization, which is always present following the cultural dynamics of the times. Although the basic values have not changed, the way Islam is shown adapts to developments [12]. Islam has the concept of balance in everything. He does not forget the world to attain the attainment of attainment and does not forget the attainment of the attainment of the world [13]. One of the major changes that affect religious life is technological advances, especially in the field of communication, which has shifted the pattern of interaction and culture of society.

Information communication technology has a huge effect on society, one of which is religious life [14]. Social media as a result of the development of technology today plays a very important role in the spread of Islamic teachings where technology is increasingly developing rapidly and has a great influence in daily life, this also has an impact on the existence of the holy text of the Qur'an.

Along with technological advancements, the Qur'an is no longer only available in conventional form but also in digital form [15].

The digital Qur'an is an application that houses the Qur'an in a small electronic device, either in a smartphone or in the form of a CD [16]. The existence of the Qur'an in digital form is a form of digitalization, which is the process of transformation from traditional use to digital technology. This process is influenced by increasingly modern industrial and technological advancements, as well as an increasing dependence on digital operational systems [17]. The development of functions for access to the Qur'an should also always be pursued by Muslim scientists in the field of Qur'anic science, because future Muslims will increasingly need variations in the uses and functions of smart software and hardware for their daily needs [18].

The phenomenon of digital media use affects human behavior [19], including in religious matters. Now, religious practices are not only carried out physically or traditionally, but have also reached the digital realm. Religious applications have sprung up and offer various features that make it easier for people to carry out religious teachings, one of which is the pro Muslim application [20]. The muslim pro application is an application that has various features that can make it easier for a Muslim to worship and learn the Quran. The features in the muslim pro application are very diverse and this muslim pro application can be accessed for free and paid according to your needs [7]. Its presence is a clear example of the integration of technology in the spiritual life of modern Muslim society.

This phenomenon is in line with the **Living Qur'an** approach, which is an approach that emphasizes how the Qur'an is not only read as a text, but also lived, practiced, and brought to life in real life [8]. In this context, the use of the Muslim Pro application is a new form of the people's reception of the Qur'an in the digital age, which at the same time reflects how interaction with revelation develops through technological media.

Based on this, this study aims to examine the user's **reception** of the Muslim Pro application in an effort to increase spiritual closeness to the Qur'an, using the Living Qur'an approach. The main focus of this research is to understand how users bring the Qur'anic values to life through digital applications, as well as how these applications affect their spirituality patterns amidst the current of modern technology.

Research Methods

This research is a type of field research, where researchers directly collect data from active users of the Muslim Pro application through observation, interviews, and documentation [22]. The goal is to explore how the user's reception of the Muslim Pro application forms in the context of increasing spiritual closeness to the Qur'an. The main source in this study is the data from interviews with Muslim Pro users who actively use the digital Qur'an features, daily verses, tafsir, dhikr, and other Islamic features available in the application. The researcher selected informants from the youth group who had used the Muslim Pro application regularly. The secondary sources are obtained from various supporting literature, such as books, scientific journals, articles, and digital references relevant to the topic of Living Qur'an, digital technology in religion, and reception studies of the Qur'an.

As an analysis knife, the researcher used the theory of Horizon of Expectation from Hans Robert Jauss. This theory explains that the reader (in this context: the application user) interprets the text based on their individual expectations, experiences, and personal context [23]. Therefore, the reception of the Qur'an through digital media such as Muslim Pro can vary greatly depending on the user's background, needs, and expectations. This theory allows researchers to capture the diversity of forms of digital spirituality that emerge through user interaction with the Qur'an within the app.

Result

Description of Muslim Pro as a Living Media Qur'an

The term application is taken from the English word "*application*" which is interpreted as application or use. Literally, application is an application of software or software developed for the purpose of performing certain tasks. As for digital itself, as reported by KBBI, digital is related to numbers for a certain calculation system. The word digital comes from the Greek language, namely Digitus which means finger [24].

Digital applications in this day and age are incalculable, one of the digital applications that is often used is the Digital Qur'an. The Qur'an is the legal basis that is used as a guideline for the life of Muslims. The Qur'an contains the words of Allah SWT which were revealed to the Prophet Muhammad through the intermediary of the alamin spirit (angel Jibril) to be read, understood and practiced [25].

The Muslim pro application is present as a Living Qur'an media that bridges the spiritual needs of Muslims with the advancement of digital technology. The muslim pro application is a comprehensive smartphone

application on IOS and Android made by Bitsmedia, a company from Singapore which was first launched in the month of Ramadan in 2010 where this application functions as a means for Muslims [26]. Equipped with features such as scripture reading, murattal audio from various reciters, thematic verse search, and quick access to interpretation, this application provides an interactive and accessible religious experience [27].

The presence of Muslim pros allows users to interact directly with the Qur'an anytime and anywhere, making religious practices no longer limited by space and time. A year after launching the Muslim Pro application on Apple, Britsmedia also launched the Muslim Pro application for the Android platform. After that, Muslim Pro users began to increase in several developing countries such as Indonesia, Malaysia, and India. This Muslim Pro app has about 14 translated languages. In addition to Indonesian and English, the creators of this application also provide translations for Spanish, Dutch, German, and so on. To use this application, users will be asked for a number of data such as location (network and GPS-based), photo/media storage, phone and equipment identity [28].

More than just a means of reading and listening to the Qur'an, Muslim Pro is also a tool to deepen the understanding of Islam. The tafsir feature provided allows users to understand the meaning of Qur'anic verses in the context of daily life, thus helping the process of internalizing Quranic values in a practical way. In the context of Living Qur'an, this application is not only a passive medium, but also encourages the creation of active spiritual involvement, [29] Where users not only read, but also make this application a guide to life. Thus, Muslim Pro presents a new form of digital interaction that is able to strengthen the individual's relationship with Divine revelation in the age of technology.

Reception of Use of the Application

User reception of the Muslim Pro application shows a positive tendency in utilizing digital technology to support daily religious practices. The majority of respondents stated that their main review of using this application was because of the practicality factor. Several users expressed that they did not like having to carry the Al-Quran mushaf everywhere, so that this application became an efficient solution. In addition, the need for other information about religion such as prayer schedules, automatic adhan, audio murattal, dhikr readings are the main considerations in choosing Muslim pro as a means of digital religion [29].

From of all the features available, the most frequently accessed by users include the digital Quran, prayer times and direction of the Qibla, and the

automatic adhan feature. This feature is considered to help users maintain consistency in worship and facilitate access to religious information. Several respondents also mentioned the community feature as a part that adds value to the religious experience in this application. The user-friendly application interface and simple appearance also support comfort in using it [30]

However, among the user receptions above there are some critical notes on the technical aspects of this application. One of the most frequently conveyed is the appearance of ads that are quite annoying, especially for users who have not upgraded to the premium version. In addition, there have been complaints about the loss of some features after updating the application, which is considered to reduce the quality of use. Although most users still consider this application helpful and worth using because of its main use in supporting digital worship activities.

The Influence of Pro Muslims on Spiritual Closeness

In terms of influence on spiritual closeness, Most of the Muslim Pro users state that this app helps them get closer to the Qur'an and other religious activities in general. Through its features, this application encourages the formation of more consistent worship routines. Some users claim that they have become more frequent in reading the Qur'an because of the ease of access offered by the application. In addition, the existence of routine notifications is a spiritual reminder in the midst of daily busyness.

Some respondents also mentioned that Muslim Pros played a role in influencing the way they understood the Qur'an, although not all felt a significant impact. The interpretation and translation features in this application are considered to help users in understanding the scriptures in a more in-depth way, although the level of utilization can vary. This application serves as a bridge between the text of the Qur'an and real life, especially those who previously rarely accessed the commentary directly.

Spiritual experience is also an important aspect expressed by some users. In some special situations, the app provides a sense of calm and spiritual connection, especially when users do not have access to conventional means of worship. This shows that the Muslim Pro application not only functions as a tool for worship, but also as a medium for strengthening personal spirituality in the context of dynamic modern life.

Discussion

The Muslim Pro application is a prayer reminder application that has complete and accurate features to help Muslims in carrying out their daily worship. The app was developed by Bitsmedia Pte Ltd and has been downloaded more than 100 million times on the Google Play Store. The app was launched in 2010 by Singapore-based Bitsmedia Ltd, founded by Erwan Mace. Erwan Mace is a French software engineer who moved to Singapore in 2008. He has a background as a mobile app developer for major companies such as Google, Nokia, and Vedafone [31].

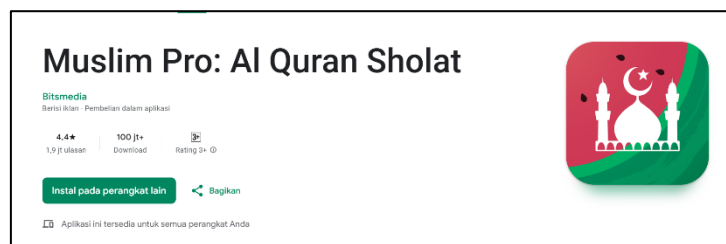


Figure 1. Muslim Pro app icon display

The Muslim Pro app brings a variety of essential features designed to meet the spiritual needs of Muslims in their daily lives. Among them are the following: (1) Prayer Time; (2) Adhan; (3) Qibla Directional Indicator; (4) Community; (5) Tasbih; (6) Nearby Mosque; (7) Nearby Halal Place; (8) Hijri Calendar; (9) Asmaul Husna; (10) The Reading of the Scriptures; (11) Zakat calculator; (12) Daily inspiration; (13) Islamic News and Media; (14) Prayer; (15) Messages; (16) Live Makkah; (17) Popular Verse; (18) The Qur'an and Translations; (19) Personal Tracker; (20) Hajj and Umrah Guide; (21) Hajj Journey; (22) Vacation with Halal Booking; (23) Aviation[32].

Many use this app because of its accurate prayer time reminders according to the user's location, qibla direction, and Islamic calendar to monitor important days in Islam. The digital Qur'an feature complete with reading, audio murattal, translation, and commentary in multiple languages, allows users to read, listen, and even memorize the Qur'an easily and flexibly. In addition, there is also a collection of daily prayers and dhikr, as well as information on halal restaurants and nearby mosques, making this application very practical for Muslims, especially when traveling.

Here are some layer shots of the features of the Muslim Pro app:

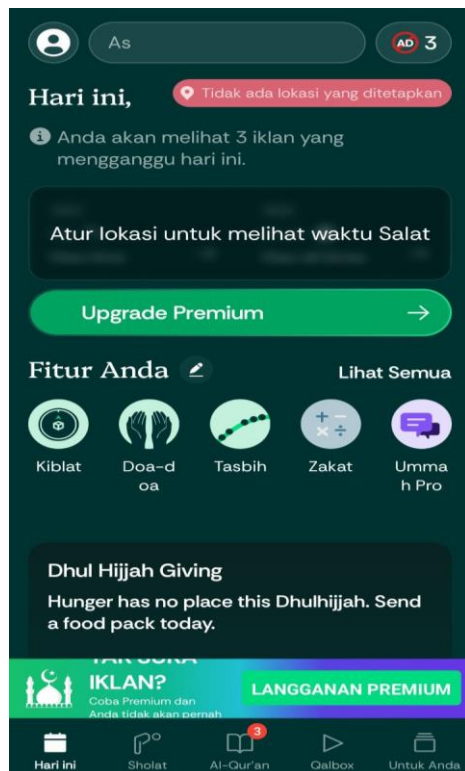


Figure 2. Initial view of the Muslim Pro app

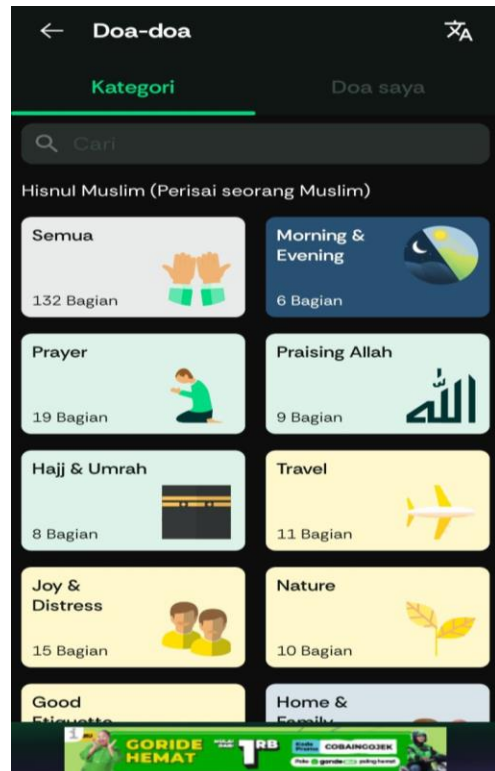


Figure 3. Main Menu View

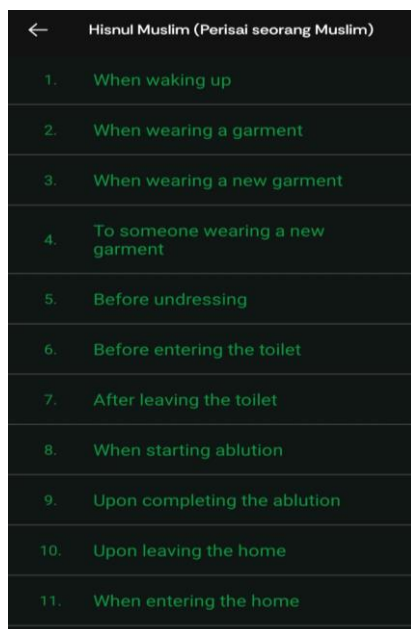


Figure 3. Prayer Group View

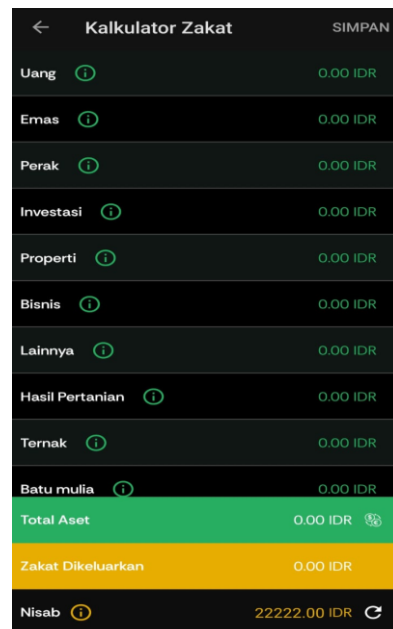


Figure 4. Zakat Display

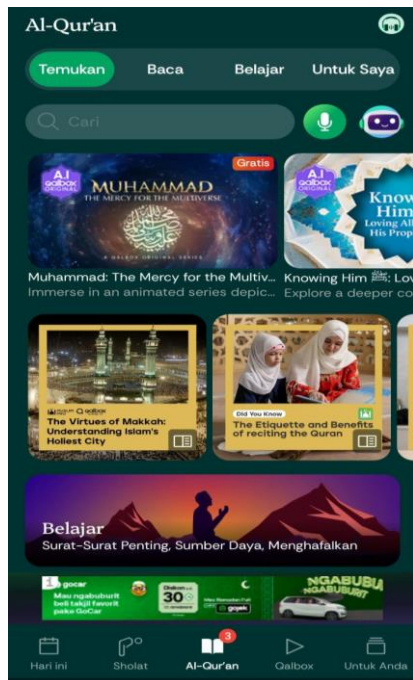


Figure 5. Display of the Qur'an Menu

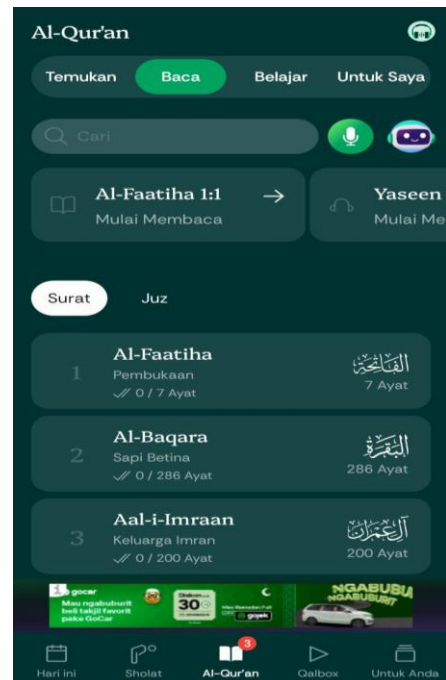


Figure 6. Surah Interface Display

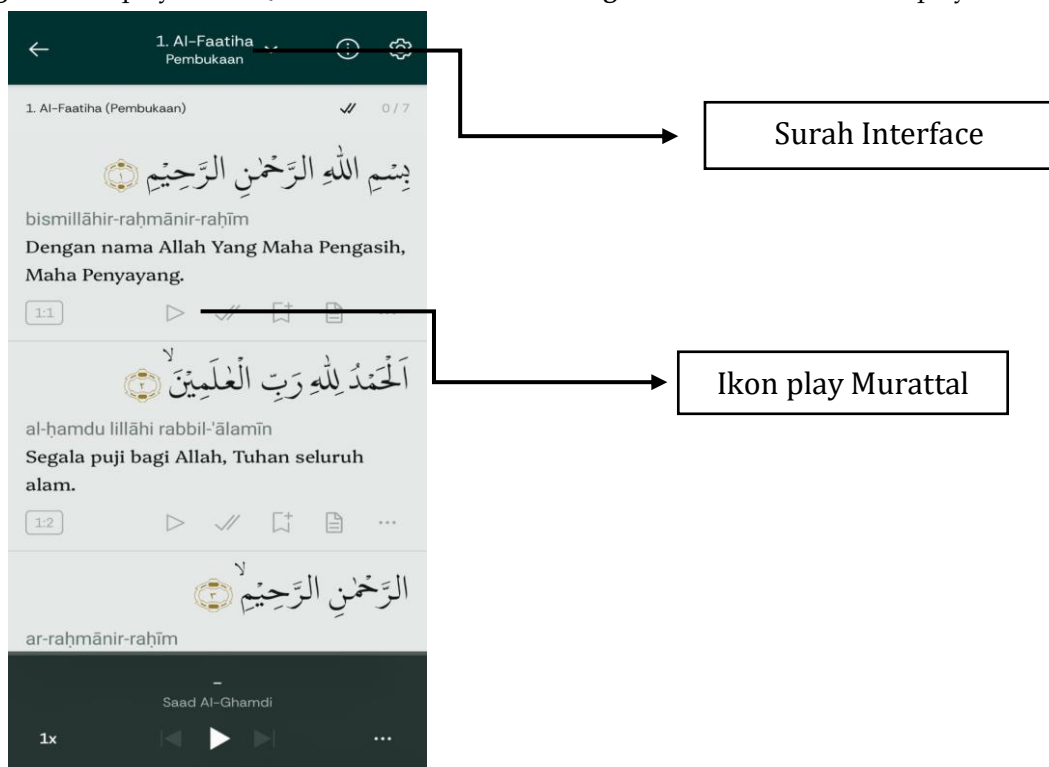


Figure 7. Surah Interface Display and Murattal Play

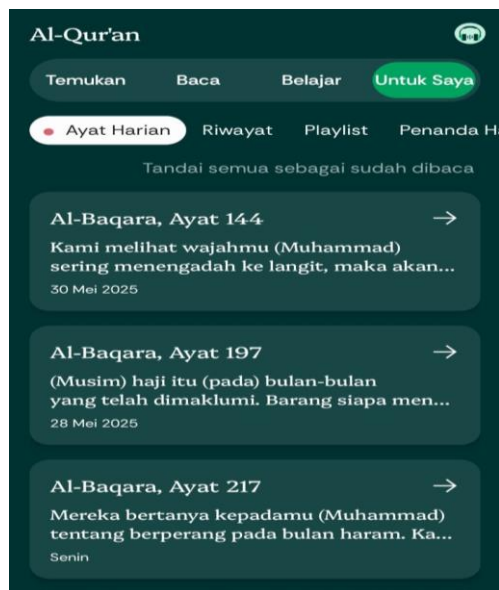


Figure 8. Daily Verse, History, and verse marker view

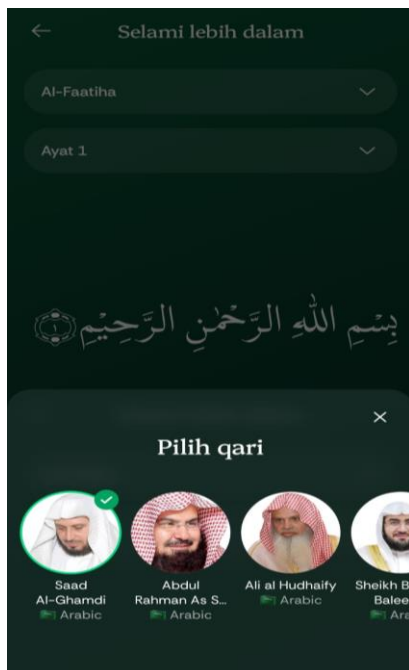


Figure 9. Murattal Display

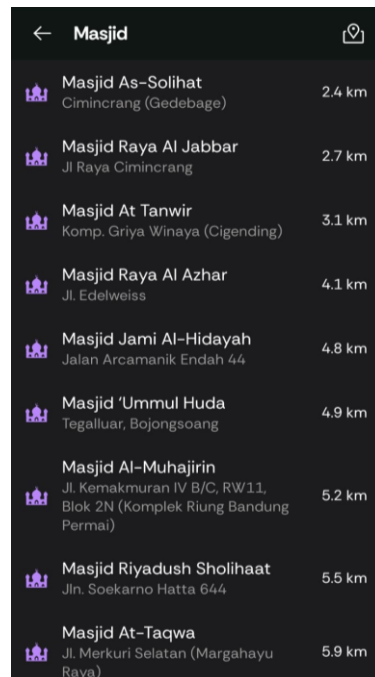


Figure 10. View of the nearest mosque

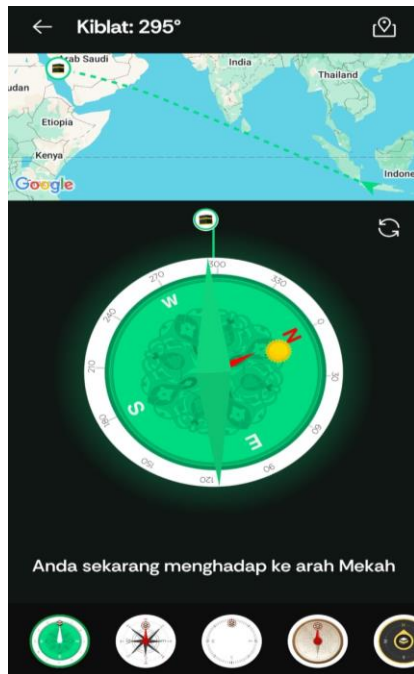


Figure 11. Qibla menu

Ahead of and during the month of Ramadan, Muslim Pro presents various exclusive features of Ramadan 2025 such as Deen Made to count down the time of suhoor and iftar, Live Quran Khatam Challenge, Ramadan Journal to record spiritual reflections, and a Community Feature that allows users to share prayers and discuss Islam in a safe space. In addition, Muslim pros also have free access to the Academy, which provides Qur'an and Arabic courses. For premium users, this application provides a more complete experience with features such as offline reading of the Qur'an, ad-free, prayer act widgets, and interactive Qur'an lessons that can enrich understanding and memorization.

Respondents in the survey showed that this app has helped them make the Qur'an closer and functional in their daily lives. Most users mention that this app has helped them make the Qur'an closer and functional in their daily lives. Furthermore, the spiritual connection of users to the Qur'an through this application is also illustrated by their recognition of the increasing routine of reading and worship. Some even mention special moments where Muslim pro apps are very helpful in maintaining the consistency of worship, especially when they are in the middle of a prayer or do not bring mushaf. In this context, pro-Muslim advocates how technology can be an extension of an authentic religious experience, where interaction with the Qur'an is no longer limited to space and time, but can be accessed in a personal and sustainable manner. Therefore,

Muslim Pro is a concrete example of how the Living Qur'an can be realized in the modern digital world.

Conclusion

The Muslim Pro application has developed into one of the digital media that accommodates the interaction of Muslims with the Qur'an in a practical and functional way. Based on the survey results, the majority of users use this application because of the ease of access to read the Qur'an, find out prayer times, and get daily worship reminders. Features such as digital Qur'an, prayer times, Qibla direction, and murattal audio become an important part of the user's religious routine, illustrating that Muslim Pro is not just a tool, but also a spiritual digital space that allows the Qur'an to "come to life" in modern life.

From the reception gathered, it can be seen that this application is able to bridge the needs of worship in the digital era, without reducing the depth of religious meaning. Users find it helpful in forming the consistency of worship, strengthening the spiritual connection with the Qur'an, and making their interactions more flexible and relevant to today's lifestyle.
